

Local Law 3-2007

ANIMAL FECES NUISANCE LAW

I. Sanitation and disposal requirements.

- A. No person who owns, harbors, keeps, or is in charge of any animal, or who has such animal in any manner under such person's control, shall allow such animal to defecate on any public property whatsoever, such as, but not limited to, thoroughfares, sidewalks, passageways, play areas, parks, streets, roads, or any other place where people congregate or walk, or upon any private property, without the permission of the owner of said property, unless such person shall immediately remove, in a suitable container, all feces deposited by such animal on any areas as set forth above.
- B. The feces shall be removed from the aforesaid areas by the person owning, harboring, keeping or in charge of any animal which deposited such feces. All such material shall be properly disposed of. Disposal of the feces in the street storm collection system, street trash container, or any other public facility, is prohibited.

II. Enforcement.

For purpose of enforcing this Local Law, appearance tickets may be issued by any Addison Village Police Officer, or Town of Addison Dog Control Officer, or any other official law enforcement officer.

III. Penalties for offenses.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Local Law shall, upon conviction, be subject to punishment by a fine of not less than \$25.00, or more than \$250.00, or by imprisonment for a term not to exceed 15 days, or both.
