Local Law # 1-1991

Authorizing the Conduct of Games of Chance by Authorized Organizations
Within the Territorial Limits of the Village of Addison, Steuben County New York State

SECTION 1: The Village of Addison, Steuben County, New York does hereby authorize the conduct of games of chance by authorized organizations upon obtaining a license therefor within the territorial limits of the Village of Addison, Steuben County, New York, in accordance with and subject to the provisions of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, this local law, and the provisions set forth by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board.

SECTION 2: The powers and duties set forth in subdivision 1 of section 194 of the General Municipal Law for the Control and supervision of games of chance and other police control required under Article 9-A if said General Municipal Law shall be exercised by the chief law enforcement officer of the Village of Addison, New York.

SECTION 8. This local law shall take effect immediately following the adoption thereof in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York and after it shall have been approved by a majority of the electors voting on a proposition submitted at a general or special election held within the Village of Addison who are qualified to vote for officers of the said Village of Addison.
