

Local Law # 1 1981
Establishing A Curfew Within The
Village Of Addison

**Section 1. CHILDREN TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN WHEN
ON THE STREETS AT NIGHT.**

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen years to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, highways, alleys, parks or public places in this Village or be in or upon any automobile or other vehicle in or upon any such places between the hours of ten o'clock p.m. and five o'clock a.m. unless such person is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other person having legal custody of such minor person, or is in the performance of an errand or duty directed by such parent, guardian or legal custodian, or is in such legal recognized employment as to make it necessary to be in or upon such places within or during said specified hours. This exception, however, shall not apply when such minor shall be playing or unnecessarily loitering in or upon any such places.

SECTION 2. PARENTS, ETC. , NOT TO ALLOW CHILDREN ON STREETS AT NIGHT.

It shall be unlawful for any parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care and custody of any person under the age of eighteen years to allow, permit or require any such minor to go in or be in or upon any of the streets, highways, alleys, parks or public places in this city , or be in or upon any automobile or other vehicle in or upon any such places, except accompanied by an adult person, between the hours of ten o'clock p.m. and five o'clock a.m. unless a reasonable necessity therefor exists.

SECTION 3.

Any police officer of this Village is hereby authorized to arrest without a warrant any person willfully violating any of the provisions of this local law and may detain such person for a reasonable time in which complaint can be made, or may let such person to bail in the sum Ten Dollars cash for appearance at the next session of Village Court.

SECTION 4.

No minor arrested under this local law shall be placed in confinement until reasonable effort shall have been made to locate and verbally notify the parent, guardian or legal custodian of such minor at the address given by minor.

SECTION 5.

Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1 or Section 2 hereof shall be and hereby is declared a disorderly person and shall on conviction be subject to be fined, not exceeding Twenty-Five Dollars for the first offense, not less than Twenty-five nor more than Fifty Dollars for the second offense, and not less than Fifty nor more than Seventy-Five Dollars for a third or any subsequent offense, or committed to county Jail for a term not exceed fifteen day, or both fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 6.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
