

LOCAL LAW NO.3 FOR 1974

A LOCAL LAW RELATING TO PERSONAL REGISTRATION

Section 1 Commencing with the effective date of this local law, registration for all Village elections shall be by personal registration in accordance with Article 17 of the Election Law of New York.

Section 2 This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Village Clerk, the Secretary of State, and the State Comptroller as provided by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law but such filing shall not be made until forty-five days after its adoption by the Board of Trustees unless with such time a valid petition as required by Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law is filed with the Village Clerks protesting the adoption of this local law, in which event this local law shall not be so filed or not take effect until after the approval of the qualified electors of this Village voting in this local law at a special or general election as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
