COMMITTEE REPORTS BUDGET AND PERSONNEL COMMITTEE

AUDIT COMMITTEE

1. **Abstract of Claims** – the audit committee reviewed abstracts totaling \$1,264.70. On a motion duly made (O'Hearn/Draxler) and carried, the abstracts were approved.

REGIONAL PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

1. **NYSERDA Painted Post/Riverside** – Chelsea Robertson reported that the drafts of the comprehensive plans are almost complete. They will include eco-friendly design guidelines, and the villages are fortunate that Pratt Institute in Brooklyn agreed to partner with STC in writing them. Pratt is highly regarded in the design field.

2. Status of ARC Applications from Prior Years

Marcia Weber and Victoria Ehlen reported that a consultant hired by the Appalachian Regional Commission spent a day in the region to evaluate the 2007 ARC project, I-86/I-99 Corridor Economic Development Blueprint. The local partners who worked on the project and who are still using the blueprint that resulted from it were extremely enthusiastic about the value of the project.
